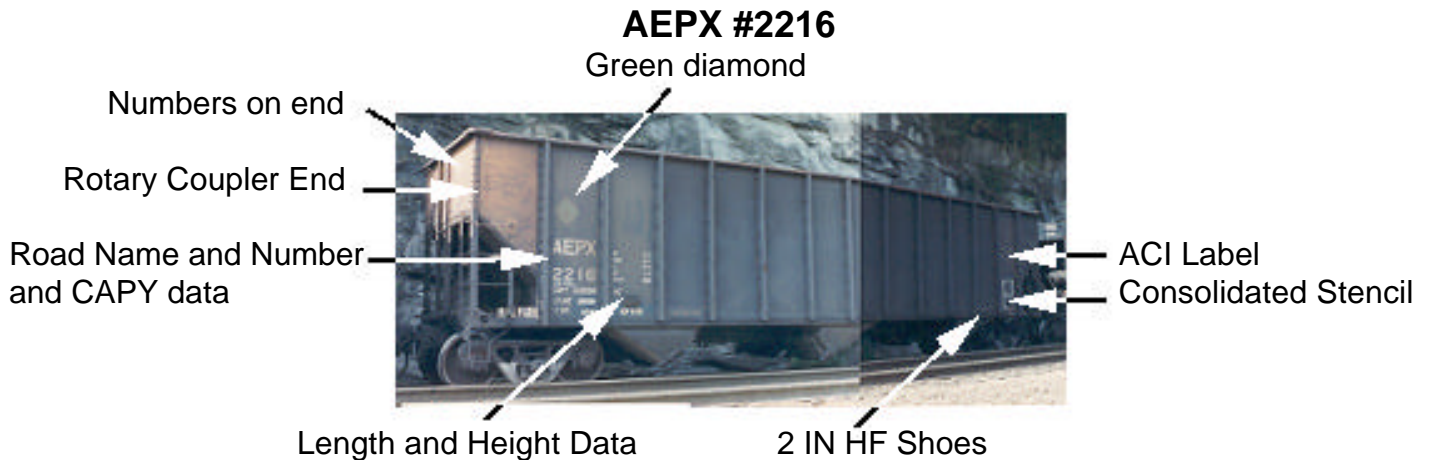


# AEPX Hopper Car Decal Placement Diagram

## 3-bay 100-ton hoppers

This decal set was designed specifically for the Con-Cor model of a Greenville 3-bay 100-ton 12-panel car. The set is laid out on the decal sheet so that each panel with text on the prototype can be cut from the sheet placed on the model whole (for example: the green diamond, reporting marks and copy data can be applied as one piece onto the first panel)



### ~~Notes~~

- ▶ American Electric owned 3200 of these cars; numbers 1-750 were leased by Appalachian Power, 751-1873 leased by Ohio Power, and 1874-3200 by Indiana & Michigan Electric, according to a 1978 Equipment Register. The car pictured above, 2216, has very small lettering (included in the set) below the reporting marks which states "Leased by SECX, return to Calla, KY". Some of these cars were later sold to DRGW, HLMX, and UFIX.
- ▶ There are both black and white end numbers for the car
- ▶ On the prototypes, there is dimensional data and other information in the yellow rotary coupler painted area on the ends, however, no clear photographs of this lettering was found, and therefore is not included in the set
- ▶ This set is not intended for the aluminum AEPX cars.
