

# SECX Hopper Car Decal Placement Diagram

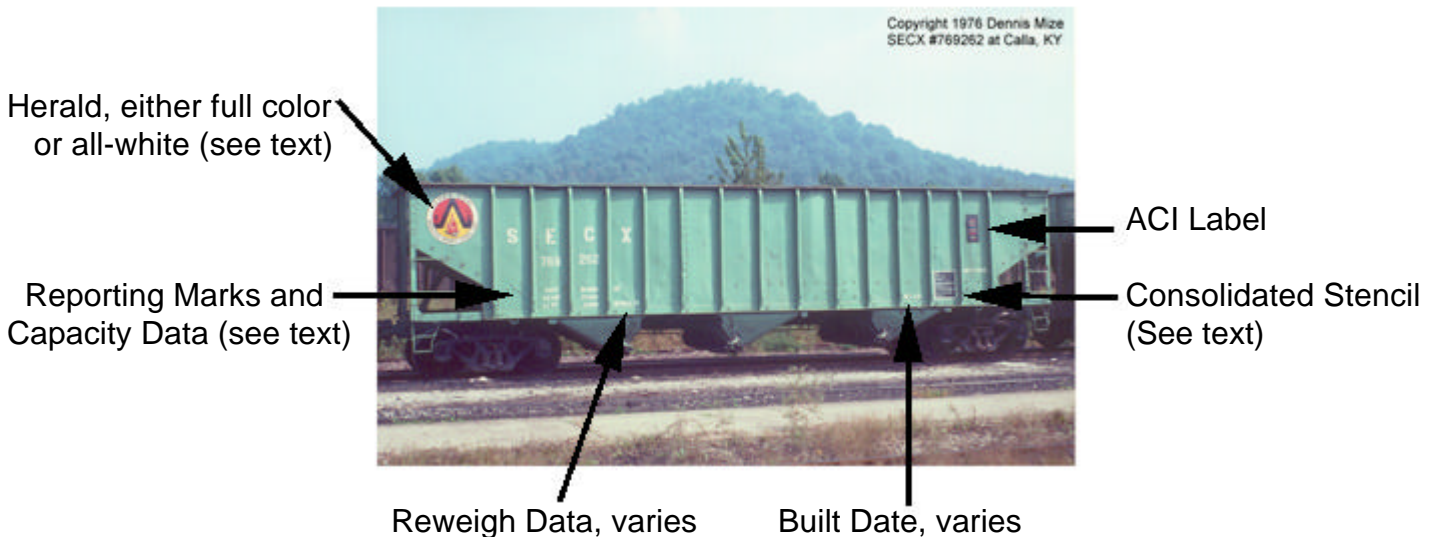
## 3-bay Green Cars

The following are actual photographs of the South East Coal Company's 3-bay hopper cars. The following photo is used as an example, if you have photos of the hoppers, please use them as well.

### ~~Notes~~

- ▶ This decal set was based on the size of the panels on the Stewart 70-ton 3-bay ribbed side hopper car, which is an almost perfect match of the prototype. The text is laid out on the set to ease application to the model by having all the text in one panel in the correct location. For instance, cut out the portion of the decal with the "E", 769, and capacity data and apply it to the model in one piece.
- ▶ This set includes two heralds, one full color and one all white. Earlier cars (apparently) received a stencil-painted all-white herald, and the later cars (or repainted cars) received the full color "stickers". A database of the white/full color cars is being compiled but is not complete.
- ▶ The ACI label colors are correct for SECX, and the consolidated stencil information was taken from hopper #773730, and is correct (in general) for all cars. The photo above shows the older style "Lube Plates" instead of the mid-1970's Consolidated Stencils. We did not include these older styles in our decal sets.
- ▶ The complete number series for these cars are 768007-774048, and includes (at most) 666 cars.
