

K&IT Locomotive Decal Placement Diagram

Blue and White Scheme

This decal set was produced using the photo below. It only includes the heralds, numbers, pilot stripes and a white dot (to represent the painted poling pocket). We suggest using a Microscale set for the two yellow stripes and the step edge stripes.

- ▶ Body is painted C&O Enchantment Blue with Refer White stripe. We think that the pilot faces are black. Note that all handrails and grab irons are blue (no safety white or yellow on ends). Truck sideframes, fuel tanks, and exhaust stack are all silver. The journal box lids on all trucks in this scheme are painted yellow also.
- ▶ The yellow stripes are not included in this set, due to the inability of our printer to correctly reproduce the color. We instead suggest using a Microscale set for the stripes. The upper stripe is approximately 2 inches wide, and the frame stripe is approximately 6 inches wide. The step edges also have yellow stripes in them, approximately 2 inches wide as well. If you are unable to locate the stripe decals, please contact us and we will work on the situation with you.
